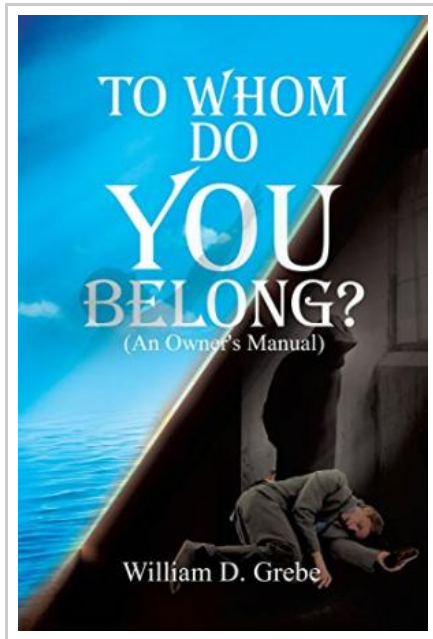




To Whom Do You Belong?
