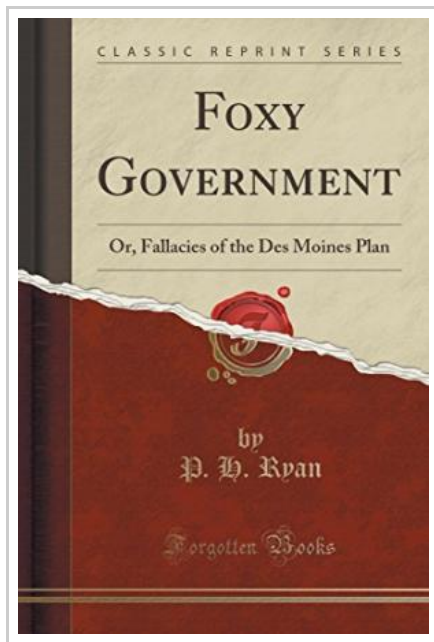




Foxy Government: Or, Fallacies of the Des Moines Plan (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)
