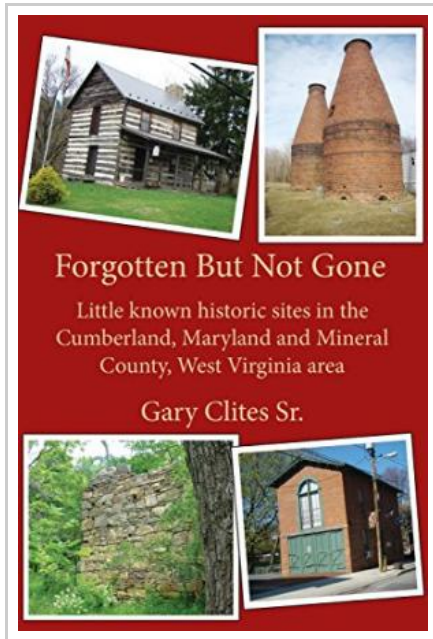




Forgotten But Not Gone: Little Known Historic Sites in the Cumberland, Maryland and Mineral County, West Virginia Area (Paperback)
