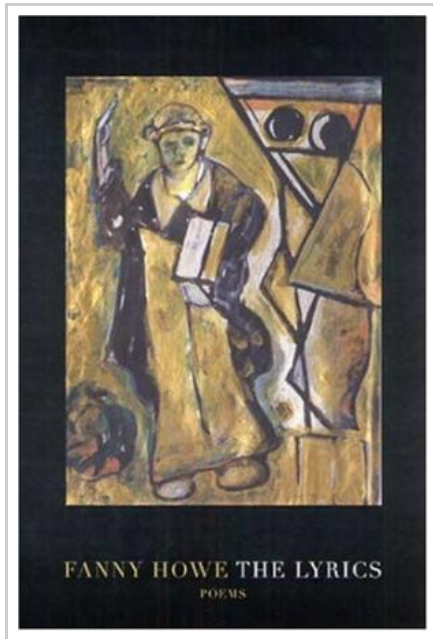




The Lyrics
